Entry Requirements:

Satisfy general university entry requirements (5 O'Levels / 3 O'Levels + 2 A'Levels)
Grade 5 certificate Theory and Practical (*primary* instrument) from ABRSM, Trinity-Guildhall (London) or equivalent.

Applicants with deficiencies can enter our Preliminary Music Program and take MUCT103/104 (Music Foundations I/II), MUCT105/106 (Aurals I/II), as well as recommended primary instrument Applied Lessons as qualifying pre-requisites.
